Thank you to all who are helping us financially with the unexpected need to replace our two projectors in the sanctuary. I shared with the church family that our non-working projector was going to cost over \$6500 to repair, and we figured the other projector, since they both run the same number of hours, isn't far behind in needing some repairs. The good news is we can replace them with newer laser projectors that are brighter, sharper pictures, and do not need high heat projector bulbs that need to be replaced every two years at the cost of \$1,400. The cost of the new projectors will be \$31,000. which, as I said earlier, was not a foreseen item placed in our yearly budget. So again, thank you to those who are able to help us defray the cost of those.

Finally, I want to express my heartfelt thanks to all of you for being a people of prayer. Thank you to the women's prayer groups that meet Wednesday and Friday. Thank you to the prayer team for our weekend prayer focus each month. Thank you to the pastor's prayer partners who meet with me each week. I know we all sense the presence of God when we gather. He is working in our midst. These are days of great opportunity for us to share the good news of Jesus with others and be His light in our world.




