Pastor's Corner

On Sunday morning, January first, we are going to share in the Word of God in a slightly different way than usual. Rather than one of our pastors preaching, we are going to have a pastoral "discussion" with all of our pastors. We are going to spend the 'sermon' part of the service sharing about the life of John the Baptist or the Baptizer. John is chosen by God, filled with the Holy Spirit from birth, as the person who would prepare the way for the ministry of the Lord Jesus Christ, the promised Messiah. His ministry is so critical that he has written about it in all four of the gospels.

Matthew's gospel 3:3 quotes the prophet Isaiah "A voice of one calling in the desert, prepare the way for the Lord, make straight paths for him." Mark, unlike Matthew and Luke, does not begin his gospel with the events surrounding the birth of Jesus. He begins with John in the midst of his ministry, introducing Jesus as he begins his public ministry.

Mark again quotes the prophets Isaiah and Malachi "I will send my messenger ahead of you, who will prepare your way: "a voice of one calling in the desert prepare the way for the Lord make straight paths for him." Luke quotes the same Isaiah passage with some additional verses, including "And all mankind will see God's salvation."

One of the questions I will ask our pastors on January first is, "In this new year, 2023, how can their specific areas of ministry make straight paths for the way of the Lord? How can our ministries help mankind see the salvation of the Lord? Our pastors have different areas of ministry in our church body, yet each of us has a heart to see our ministry used by God to help others come to Christ as their Savior and Lord. I'm really looking forward to our sharing together.

May I ask you the same question? As we enter the year

2023, how can your life, your testimony, and your ministry "prepare the way for the Lord to enter someone's life? How can you help make a straight spiritual path for someone to find Christ? Help to answer the questions and dispel their doubts? Help them to experience the love and grace of God in their lives? Let's ministry together this year, pastors and people.



Clear Way Clinic

About 15% of the women who come to Clearway Clinic for help with an unplanned pregnancy leave our offices and go on to choose abortion. We make it



very clear to the women that we love them no matter what they decide. An abortion procedure can cause unexpected emotional pain. For many women who are unprepared for their own emotional reaction, they may carry this pain in secret for years, even decades. 90% of people suffering from post-abortion distress report that they don't know where to go for help. Clearway offers an 11-week Bible study which helps men and women move through stages of grief in a healthy way and to a complete healing and restoration with God. For those interested in facilitating this Bible study in partnership with Clearway, we are offering a one-day training. The training will supply participants with a Leaders Manual, study book and access to audio trainings.
