Pastor's Corner

Have you been enjoying the Bible Recap Project as much as I have? When we launched it in January, it was so exciting to be starting this journey with the whole church family. It has been wonderful having many conversations around the readings. The Bible never ceases to amaze me; there is something new, challenging, and encouraging every time I read it. So far, we have completed 120 days of reading and ten books of the Bible! I want to encourage you to keep at it. If you have missed a few days, that is OK. Don't let that deter you from picking it back up and continuing. The Bible is God's written word to us so we can learn and grow in our understanding of who He is and who we are in Christ so we can live life out of that revelation. The challenge is when our busy lives keep us from the very thing that gives us True Life, God, and His Word. Please be encouraged to be in God's word every day. Asking someone to read along with you and discuss what you are experiencing together is a great way to help you be consistent at it.

As I was reading this past week, Psalms 34 stood out to me, and I wanted to include it in this month's Pastor's Corner. We notice that David wrote this at a time in his life when he had to pretend to be insane just to survive. Does that sound like your life right now? As followers of Jesus, we might look insane to the world because of what we believe, and we feel we have to pretend or ignore or shelter just to survive. Take heart as you read this psalm and see how God is with us during the times when we feel like we won't survive. After you read through it a couple of times, send a text to someone about the verses that spoke to you.

(For those of you reading in a Hebrew bible, a fun fact is that this psalm is an acrostic poem, the verses of which begin with the successive letters of the Hebrew alphabet.)

Psalms 34

Of David. When he pretended to be insane before Abimelek, he drove him away, and he left.

- 1 I will extol the LORD at all times; his praise will always be on my lips.
- 2 I will glory in the LORD; let the afflicted hear and rejoice.
- 3 Glorify the LORD with me; let us exalt his name together.
- 4 I sought the LORD, and he answered me; he delivered me from all my fears.
- 5 Those who look to him are radiant; their faces are never covered with shame.
- 6 This poor man called, and the LORD heard him; he saved him out of all his troubles.
- 7 The angel of the LORD encamps around those who fear him, and he delivers them.
- 8 Taste and see that the LORD is good; blessed is the one who takes refuge in him.
- 9 Fear the LORD, you his holy people, for those who fear him lack nothing.
- 10 The lions may grow weak and hungry, but those who seek the LORD lack no good thing.
- 11 Come, my children, listen to me; I will teach you the fear of the LORD.
- 12 Whoever of you loves life and desires to see many good days,
- 13 keep your tongue from evil and your lips from telling lies.
- 14 Turn from evil and do good; seek peace and pursue it.
- 15 The eyes of the LORD are on the righteous, and his ears are attentive to their cry;
- 16 but the face of the LORD is against those who do evil, to blot out their name from the earth.
- 17 The righteous cry out, and the LORD hears them; he delivers them from all their troubles.
- 18 The LORD is close to the brokenhearted and saves those who are crushed in spirit.
- 19 The righteous person may have many troubles, but the LORD delivers him from them all;
- 20 he protects all his bones, not one of them will be broken.
- 21 Evil will slay the wicked; the foes of the righteous will be condemned.
- 22 The LORD will rescue his servants; no one who takes refuge in him will be condemned.








New Parenting Class Begins April 30
