

### Pastor's Corner

#### Church family,

As we approach the start of a new school year, I am excited to share with you all where God is leading our student ministry and call on you all to be a part of it. Last week, I concluded reading Gospelize Your Youth Ministry: A Spicy "New" Philosophy of Youth Ministry (That's 2,000 Years Old), in which author Greg Stier, Founder and CEO of Dare 2 Share, unpacks the ministry model found in the book of Acts. Overall from the book, the chapter on intercessory prayer stuck out to me the most. Stier writes, "A 'prayer first' philosophy permeated the whole of the early church. From the first page to the last, the stories in the book of Acts drip with intercession. So should the story of your youth ministry." Reflecting on this quote led me to the follow up question: Does our church not just drip, but "overflow" (the theme of Nazarene Youth Conference this past July) with intercessory prayers for our students?

I am so appreciative of the prayer team's August Prayer Weekend focus of praying for the next generation. As Lynne Fortin shared about the Prayer Weekend, the statistics revealing the number of students facing anxiety, depression, fear, loneliness, addiction, and/or sexual related sin are staggering. We need to know that these are not just physical battles our youth are facing, but spiritual ones. This is the exact focus of what we will be teaching our students this fall during Sunday morning youth class and Wednesday night youth group. By looking through the theological lens of God's character, our goal is to equip students to face spiritual battles from a biblical perspective. We will be looking at God's truth amidst lies, His peace amidst anxiety, God's sovereignty amidst fear, His hope amidst depression, God's patience amidst anger, and His love amidst shame.

Back to my opening sentence, I am calling on all

of you to be a part of this series. How you may be asking? Through intercessory prayer! Acts 4:31 says, "After they prayed, the place where they were meeting was shaken. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke the word of God boldly." Whether on Sunday morning or Wednesday night, the youth room often shakes due to our active youth group games and activities. However, this fall, what if our youth room is shaken by the intercessory prayers of our church family? Please, I urge you, be praying for our students this fall! It is only through prayer that our students will experience victory over the stronghold of the enemy. These spiritual battles are too big for me, our students, and our church to face on our own. We need God and therefore, we need to pray. Stier puts it this way in the book mentioned above, "Prayer is the portal through which we yield ourselves to the power of the Holy Spirit. The act of prayer is an act of dependence. Prayer is us letting God know that we can't, but we believe He can." I believe that God will do a work in the lives of our students this fall and many will experience victory over the spiritual battles they are facing because God is a God of the impossible. It is time to stop complaining about or mourning over the next generation, and start interceding for them. Can I count you in?

This is my prayer: "God, you know the spiritual battles our students are facing. It breaks your heart more than it does ours. Whether our students know it or not, they need you. May their daily losses on the battlefield of life humble them to the truths of your Word and may your truth transcend the enemy's lies. Cast him aside and grab a hold of our student's hearts. May your everlasting love fill them with joy, hope, peace, and purpose. You are a God of victory over the enemy. Be victorious once more in the lives of our students, we pray. The battle belongs to you." That is my prayer for our students this fall. May God hear yours.
