### Pastor's Corner

Throughout his epistles, Paul uses the illustration of the human body to describe how the church, the body of Christ, should function. An example of this is found in Ephesians 4:15-16, which says, "speaking the truth in love, we will grow to become in every respect the mature body of him who is the head, that is, Christ. From him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work." In this passage, Paul uses plural pronouns to highlight the communal relationship that the church should have with one another. Just as the human body is joined, held, grows, and works together, the church is to do the same.

It can sometimes be tempting to segment ourselves based on our differences in age, interest, and background. However, these differences are not meant to divide us, but unite us. This is what Paul is getting at in 1 Corinthians 12:17-20 when he says, "If the whole body were an eye, where would the sense of hearing be? If the whole body were an ear, where would the sense of smell be? But in fact God has placed the parts in the body, every one of them, just as he wanted them to be. If they were all one part, where would the body be? As it is, there are many parts, but one body." Just like the human body is made up of unique parts, so should the church be with its people. This is the way God intentionally created and designed both the human body and the church body.

Let me highlight again what Paul says in 1 Corinthians 12:18, "in fact God has placed the parts in the body, every one of them, just as he wanted them to be." In the same way that God created the eye to benefit the human body, God has wired you to help build His Church. According to Paul, this is a fact. If you are a part of Valley Chapel, let me tell you this: you are vital! You have an essential role to play in the growth and wellbeing of our church.

This is the message that I hope to communicate to our students through our upcoming Rake and Run service project. On November 19, our student ministry will head to different homes of people in our church and assist them with yard work. Following the service project, we will head back to the Valley Chapel Café for a soup dinner with other youth groups from local Nazarene churches.

God has designed me to work with students. The Rake and Run service project fits right into my spiritual gifting. However, cooking soup for a multi-youth group gathering is nowhere in my skillset. You can ask my wife. So as the body of Christ, let's work together! As our student ministry serves the needs of some in our church family by helping them with fall clean up, would you consider meeting our need and provide a soup for our gathering at 5pm on November 19. Please contact me (pastormatt@valleychapel.us) if you are willing to help or if you have any questions. Let's model for our students what Paul is talking about in Ephesians 5:16-16 and 1 Corinthians 12:17-20 because we are better when we are united together.
